

GROOMING TIPS ...

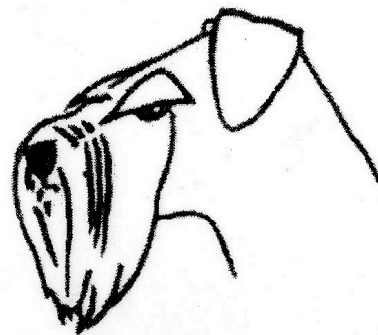
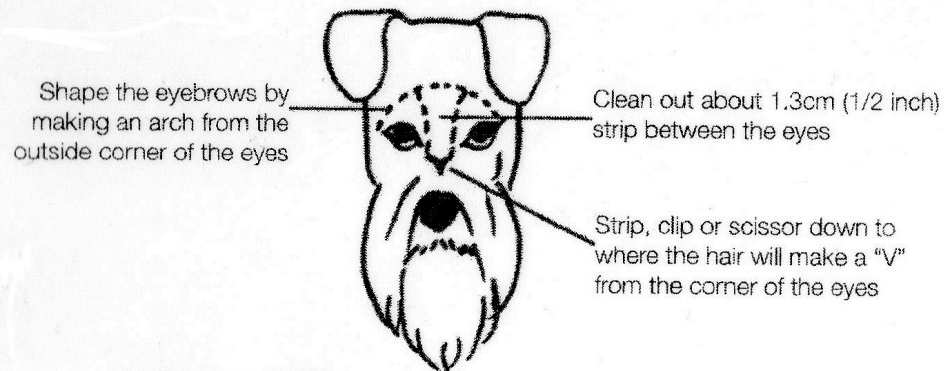
Part of the appeal of a Schnauzer as a breed is the way they are groomed.

Because of the character of the fur/coat of the Schnauzer regular grooming is necessary to help the dog to shed the "dead" hair that they don't shed voluntarily. Regular brushing and combing of the longer hair on the legs will be a huge step

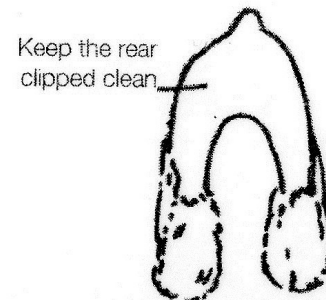
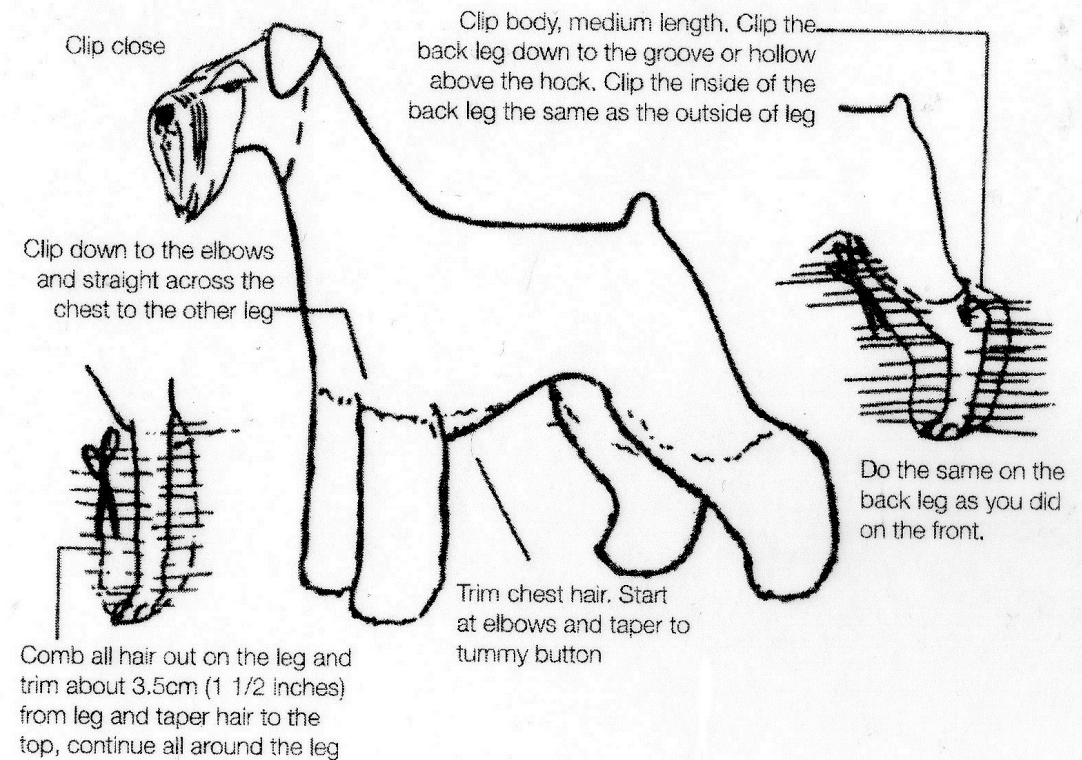
towards having a smart looking dog. This has to happen though every day or every other day.

If you are interested in grooming your Schnauzer some breeders might be prepared to initially help you.

Here are some of the essential grooming tasks for all Schnauzer owners to undertake:



Do not remove hair from under the eye



Comb all hair down past the foot and cut excess, keep close to toes, and round looking
